- > There is a driveway and wide doors in front of the building, through which a person on a wheelchair can freely enter the museum • the ticket office and the souvenir shop are accessible for disabled visitors. Visitors on wheelchairs can easily access the three exhibition rooms on the ground floor - the room with the exposition of maquettes • the room being a reconstruction of a painter's atelier and temporary exhibitions. For the reason of the historic background of the Celejowska Tenement, the access to the six rooms on the first floor is difficult: the visitor has to climb the narrow, steep and wooden staircase. Nonetheless all the exhibition rooms are accessible for the visually impaired and blind visitors assisted by a guardian.

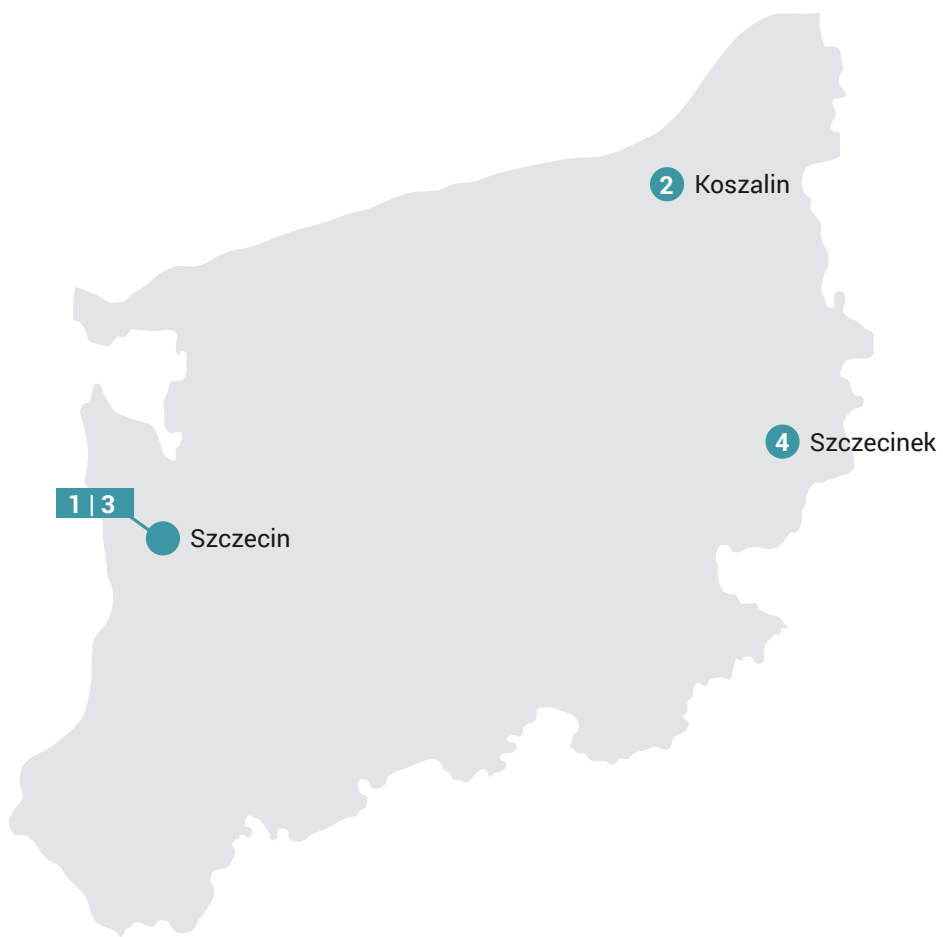
