

> There is a driveway and wide doors in front of the building, through which a person on a wheelchair can freely enter the museum • the ticket office and the souvenir shop are accessible for disabled visitors. Visitors on wheelchairs can easily access the three exhibition rooms on the ground floor - the room with the exposition of maquettes • the room being a reconstruction of a painter's atelier and temporary exhibitions. For the reason of the historic background of the Celejowska Tenement, the access to the six rooms on the first floor is difficult: the visitor has to climb the narrow, steep and wooden staircase. Nonetheless all the exhibition rooms are accessible for the visually impaired and blind visitors assisted by a quardian.

There are no access hindrances for the visitors with locomotor disabilities - all the exhibits can be reached using the wooden alleys or dirt roads. The size and the construction of the door openings of the reconstructed buildings make it impossible for a person on a wheelchair to enter the cottages
 but stopping at the entrance, one can easily see the interiors of the cottages.
